
Zhejiang Tianxin Pharmaceutical Co., Ltd. (Zhejiang Tianxin)'s capacity accounts for ■ of the total in China in 2012, and its output constitutes ■ of the national total in 2011. The company has two production bases of vitamin B6, which are located in Zhejiang and Jiangxi provinces respectively. In June 2011, the production base in Jiangxi Province was affected by flood, making Zhejiang Tianxin halt its production of vitamin B6 for maintenance. It restored production one month later. In July 2012, the company starts routine maintenance, which will reduce the supply of vitamin B6. Plus, the inventory of the product is getting less. A price rise is possible.

Xinfa Pharmaceutical Co., Ltd. is a new producer of vitamin B6 which starts in 2012. Its capacity of the product, ■, has been launched in this April. The raw material L-alanine is self-sufficient.

### 4.3 Price, 2011-July 2012

In the first five months of 2011, the ex-works price of vitamin B6 in China kept stable. However, it started to climb in that June due to the production halt of the Jiangxi production base of Zhejiang Tianxin Pharmaceutical Co., Ltd. caused by a flood, reaching its highest point of USD [redacted] /t in Sept. 2011. Zhejiang Tianxin Pharmaceutical Co., Ltd. resumes production after maintenance, and the supply of vitamin B6 returned to normal. Up to July 2012, the price has fallen and approached to the one before the surge from last June.
