1 Summary of global trade

1.1 Overview of the global trade

Globally, Kazakhstan, Vietnam, China and the US are the major exporters of yellow phosphorus, whose export volume accounts for about XX% of the world's total trade volume in 2011, while Germany, Japan, Poland, Brazil and India are the top import countries, sharing about XX% of the total import volume.

Because yellow phosphorus is not easy to be transported and stored, its flow is mainly limited between production countries and their neighboring countries. For example, Chinese yellow phosphorus mainly flows to Japan, while Kazakhstan's yellow phosphorus mainly flows to the EU countries. Besides, the main export origins have already changed from developed countries to developing countries, where the production cost of yellow phosphorus is much lower than that in the developed countries.




Figure 2.1-1 Import structure of yellow phosphorus by origin in Germany, 2011
