IV Consumption pattern of carbon black

Carbon black is an important industrial chemical. The major market of carbon black is rubber industry. Meanwhile, carbon black for tyre accounts almost 80.00% of rubber carbon black. Thereby the development of tyre industry holds the balance of carbon black market.

Beside of rubber industry, carbon block is also used extensively in plastic industry, ink industry, coating industry and battery industry, etc. In plastic industry, coating industry and ink industry, carbon block is an important pigment raw material.

Conductive carbon black, a kind of special carbon black is a necessary part in the production of traditional battery.

However, the demand for the special carbon black from these industries is small in quantity, comparing with rubber industry.
