3 Supply of aniline in China

3.1 Current production, 2008-Q1 2014

3.1.1 Production

At present, China is one of the biggest producers of aniline around the world. In order to meet the demand from downstream industries in China, most domestic producers have expanded their capacity of aniline in recent years. Although the aniline industry still maintains development in 2014, the problem of overcapacity has been more and more serious due to blind capacity expansion.

In 2013, the capacity and output of aniline in China further improved, which respectively reached XXX t/a and XXX tonnes. However, along with the increasing capacity, China's aniline market has been relatively saturated. Although part of the manufacturers still expand their production of aniline, the operating rate of the product even further falls down and more and more producers choose to reduce production.

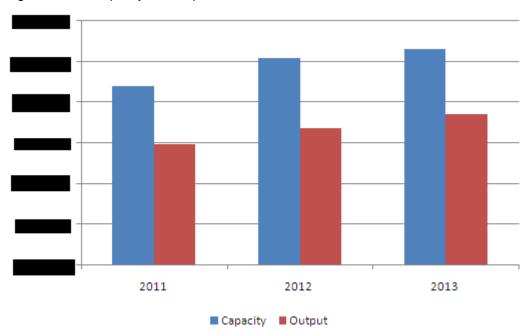


Figure 3.1.1-2 Capacity and output of aniline in China, 2011-2013

3.1.2 Producers

In general, the capacity of main aniline producers maintained steady in 2013 compared with 2012. About XXX% of the total domestic capacity of aniline is concentrated in the top three producers. In April 2014, there are 18 active aniline producers in China, among which Wanhua Chemical and Jilin Connell are the two biggest in China, with capacities of XXX t/a and XXX t/a respectively.

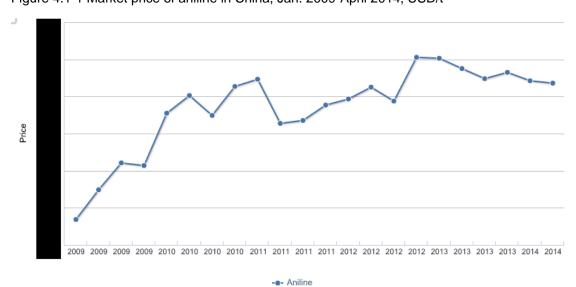
4 Trade of aniline in China, 2008-Q1 2014

4.1 Price

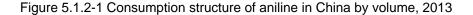


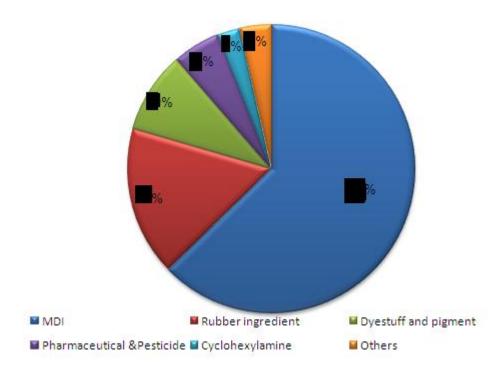
5 Consumption of aniline in China

5.1 Overall consumption (volume & value)

Aniline can be widely used in various applications, like MDI, rubber ingredients, dyestuff and its intermediates, cylclohexylamine and pharmaceutical. Thereinto, the growth of aniline consumption is mainly attributed to the increasing demand from the MDI and rubber ingredient industries, respectively accounting for about XXX% and XXX% of the total consumption. Meanwhile, most MDI producers are self-supplied with aniline.
