### 3.2.2.2 Production situation, 2006-2010

Paracetamol industry of China keeps developing rapidly in recent years driven by the large demand from both domestic and oversea markets. In 2010, Chinese enterprises totally produce █████ tonnes of paracetamol with a year-on-year increment of █████%. During 2005-2010, the CAGR has exceeded █████%.

However, there are some problems existing in paracetamol industry. First, the production of PAP, the raw material of paracetamol, is highly subject to the crude oil prices which fluctuate largely. Second, China's paracetamol production is largely influenced by overseas market, since more than █████% of Chinese paracetamol is exported. In 2008, with the expansion of some manufacturers including Hebei Jiheng, Rhodia Wuxi, Changshu Huagang, Tianjin Bofa, the capacity of Chinese paracetamol was boosted to █████t/a, which leads to more intense competition among paracetamol enterprises in the future. On the other side, the profitability of paracetamol industry declined seriously due to the markup of raw material and the rising labor cost.
