

# (2) Supply status of fluor resin

Past 10 years is a rapid development period for China's fluor resin. China's capacity of fluor resin expanded rapidly in this period from xxxt/a in 2001 to xxxt/a in 2009, with the CAGR of xxx%. Compared to the rapid development of the capacity, the growth of output of flruo resin is relatively slow. 
## 1.2.3 Market status of fluor rubber in China

## 1) Main Products

Fluor rubber 26 accounts for about xxx% of the total output of fluor rubber in China in 2010. The next are fluor rubber 246 and fluor rubber TP which account for about xxx% and xxx% respectively in 2010.

Though China's production capacity of fluor rubber expanded quickly in recent years, the products still concentrate in raw fluor rubbers such as fluor rubber 26 and fluor rubber 246, which are low-end products. And about xxx% of the fluor rubber 26 produced in China is for export, and most of which are processed into downstream products whose added-value is far more than raw fluor rubber in foreign countries and then sold in China.
