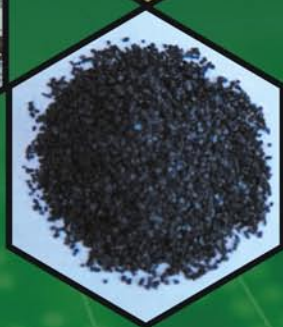
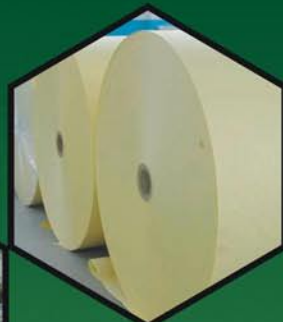

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China's forest chemicals industry thriving but starving for upgrade

China's forest chemicals industry is thriving and its output value is predicted to increase with double-digit growth rate in the coming 3 years, driven by China's high-speed development of downstream industries, including adhesive, ink, printing, paper-making, coating, rubber, leather and over 400 kilotons of oversea demand to China's forest chemicals. Also China is starving for advanced production technology, innovative deep processing forest chemicals and derivatives and long-sighted investment.

China has abundant forest resources and Chinese government has worked out the blueprint that China's forest coverage rate will reach 19% and 23% by 2010 and 2020, respectively.

China ranks the first in the fields of gum rosin, furniture, hard board, fresh and dried fruits by annual output. The output of rosin in China reaches 600 kilotons in 2007, accounting for 50% of global rosin output. The exploitable crude oleoresin in China is over 1.5 million tonnes, and it has a promising prospect in the coming 10 years.

Besides, the industries of pulp and paper, turpentine and activated carbon are also thriving and they challenge people's attention too. China's flavor and fragrance industry, with the output of nearly 20 kilotons, one third of the global output, develops quickly, driven by people's increasing desire for a more natural and healthier life.

With 10% GDP growth rate, China's adhesive, ink, printing, paper-making, coating, rubber and leather industries all develop at the annual growth rate of over 10%, which greatly promotes the domestic demand to forest chemicals and derivatives.

Developed counties including US, Japan and EU are starving for China's forest chemicals and derivatives in order to protect the forest resources in their own countries. This is

another key driven force pushing China's forest chemicals industry forward. In the first 10 months of 2007, the export of China's gum rosin, turpentine and other rosins totally reached 418 kilotons, increasing by 8.5% year on year. Although China's export tax rebate rate to gum rosin has been reduced from 13% to 5% since the second half 2007, China's export volume of gum rosin will keep stable by 2010.

However, now China's forest chemicals industry confronts bottlenecks in its further development, including supply shortage of deep processing and top-grade products, lack of scientific management for forest resource, backward production technology, small production scale and ability, serious pollution, insufficient investment in medicinal plants selection and new medicine development and etc.

It is the very time to invest in and develop the business of forest chemicals and their derivatives in China. If you have advanced production technology, innovative deep processing forest chemicals and derivatives, and abundant capital, you can share the fast development of China's forest chemicals industry. With China's low labor cost and preferential policies, your investment in China's forest chemicals industry will bring about considerable profit to you.
